# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PART NO. SPL1114 TRIPLE TREE WITH FORK COVERS  
SUZUKI VZ1600 / M95  
KAWASAKI MEANSTREAK 1500/1600

TOOLS NEEDED: 17MM SOCKET WRENCH 2MM ALLEN WRENCH THREADLOCKER

**NOTE: WE RECOMMEND USING THREADLOCKER ON ALL HARDWARE INSTALLED.**

INSTALLATION:

1. COVER YOUR TANK WITH A PROTECTIVE COVER OR TOWEL SO WHEN THE HANDLEBARS ARE REMOVED THEY DO NOT SCRATCH THE TANK.
2. USING THE 17MM SOCKET WRENCH REMOVE THE TWO NUTS HOLDING THE HANDLEBARS ONTO THE TRIPLE TREE. GENTLY REST THE HANDLEBARS ON THE COVERED TANK IF NO ONE CAN HOLD THEM FOR YOU.
3. CLEAN THE SURFACE OF THE TRIPLE TREE WITH A CLEANER SUCH AS RUBBING ALCOHOL.
4. TAKE THE TRIPLE TREE ACCENT COVER AND REMOVE THE BACKING FROM THE DOUBLE-SIDED TAPE LOCATED INSIDE THE COVER. PLACE THE COVER ON TOP OF THE TRIPLE TREE AND PRESS FIRMLY SO THE TAPE STICKS TO THE TRIPLE TREE.
5. WITH THE 2MM ALLEN WRENCH INSTALL BOTH THE FORK CAP COVERS AND THE FORK STEM COVER.
6. REINSTALL THE HANDLEBARS IN REVERSE ORDER OF REMOVAL.
